

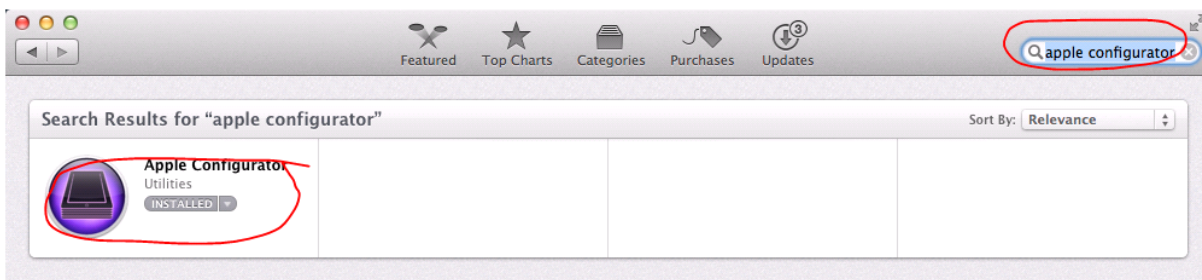
How to Use Apple Configurator to Distribute LongRange to iOS Devices

Apple Configurator is an application from Apple that enables administrators to easily apply the same configuration to iOS devices (iPads, iPhones, and iPods) in their organisations.

This article focuses on how to distribute LongRange to iOS devices.

Apple Configuration is only available on Mac OS X, so you would need to have access to a Mac computer to perform the steps described in this article.

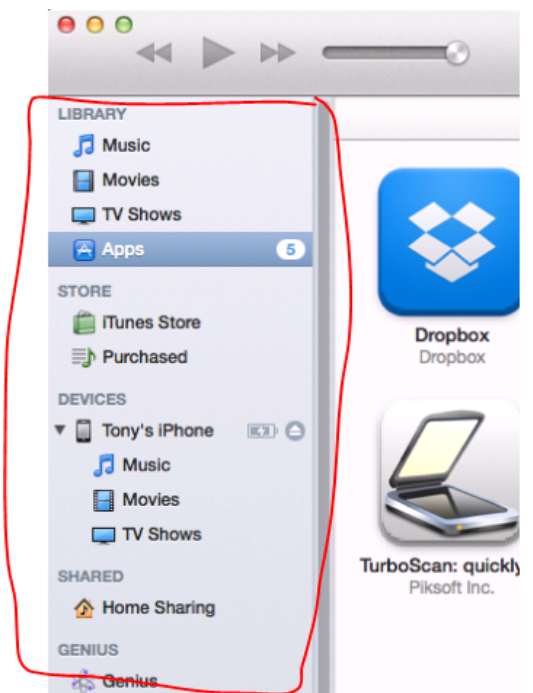
1. Download Apple Configurator from Mac App Store



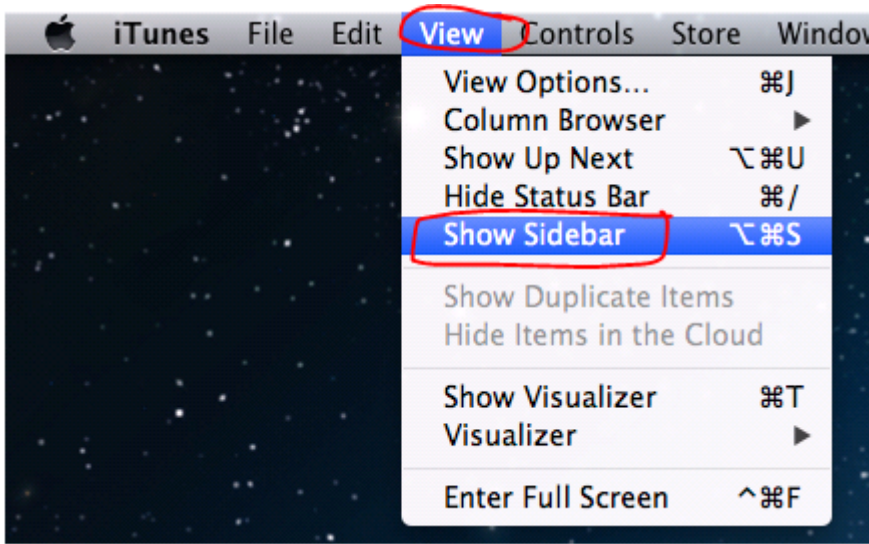
2. Download or Transfer LongRange app from App Store using iTunes

You can either download the LongRange app using iTunes from App Store, or if you already installed LongRange on your device and you want to use that particular version of LongRange, you can transfer the LongRange app currently installed on your device to iTunes, which later can be distributed to other devices using the **Apple Configurator**

First, launch iTunes and make sure that you can see the sidebar.

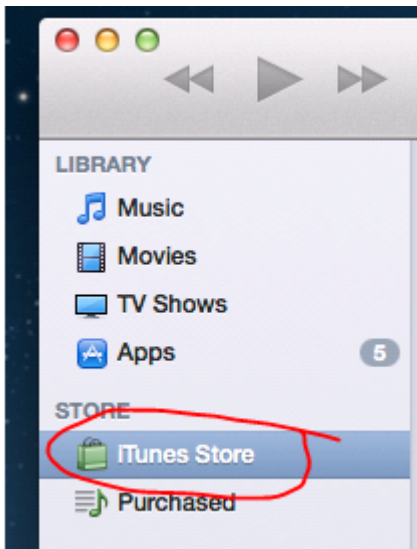


If you are not able to see the sidebar, you need to go to the 'View' menu, and choose 'Show Sidebar'



Downloading LongRange app from App Store using iTunes

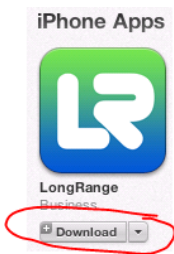
Go to the iTunes Store



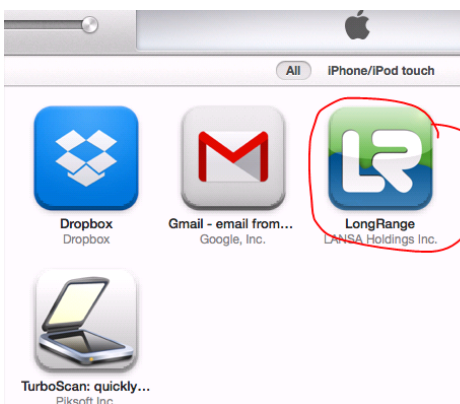
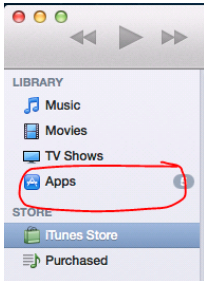
Type 'LongRange' on the search box



You will see 'LongRange' in the search result, choose "Download".

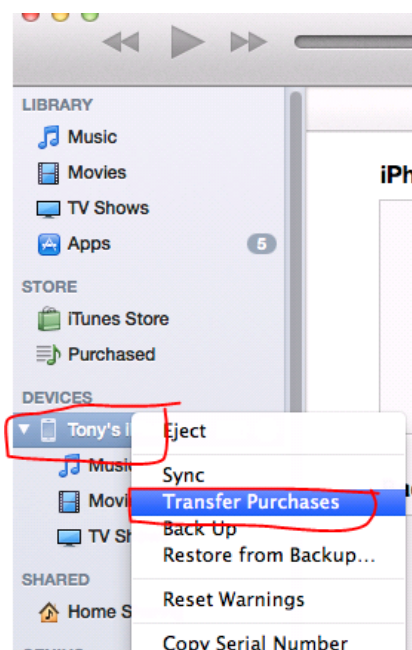


Once completed, LongRange will appear under the “Apps” section in your iTunes Library



Transferring LongRange app already installed on your device to iTunes

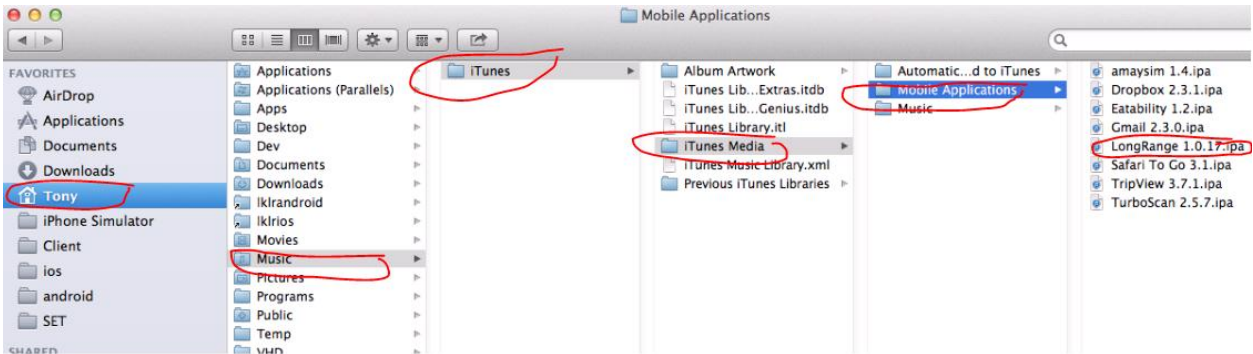
From the sidebar, show the context-menu for your device, then choose “Transfer Purchases”



3. Make a backup copy of the LongRange app in iTunes

The LongRange app you should downloaded or transferred would be placed under the user home directory/Music/iTunes/iTunes Media/Mobile Applications/

Transfer the .IPA file to a backup media for safekeeping.

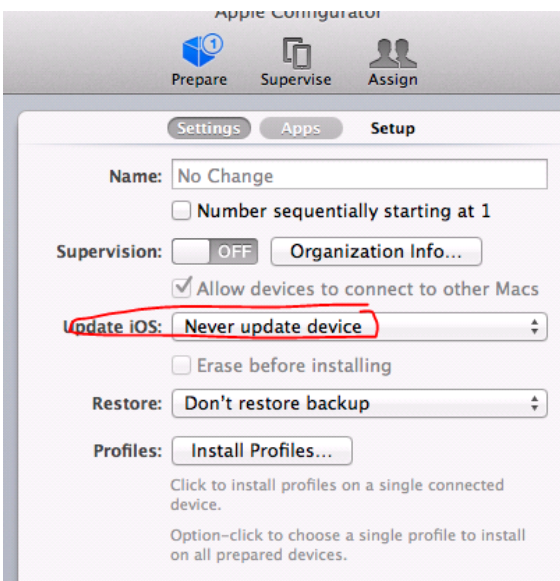


4. Add the LongRange .IPA file to Apple Configurator

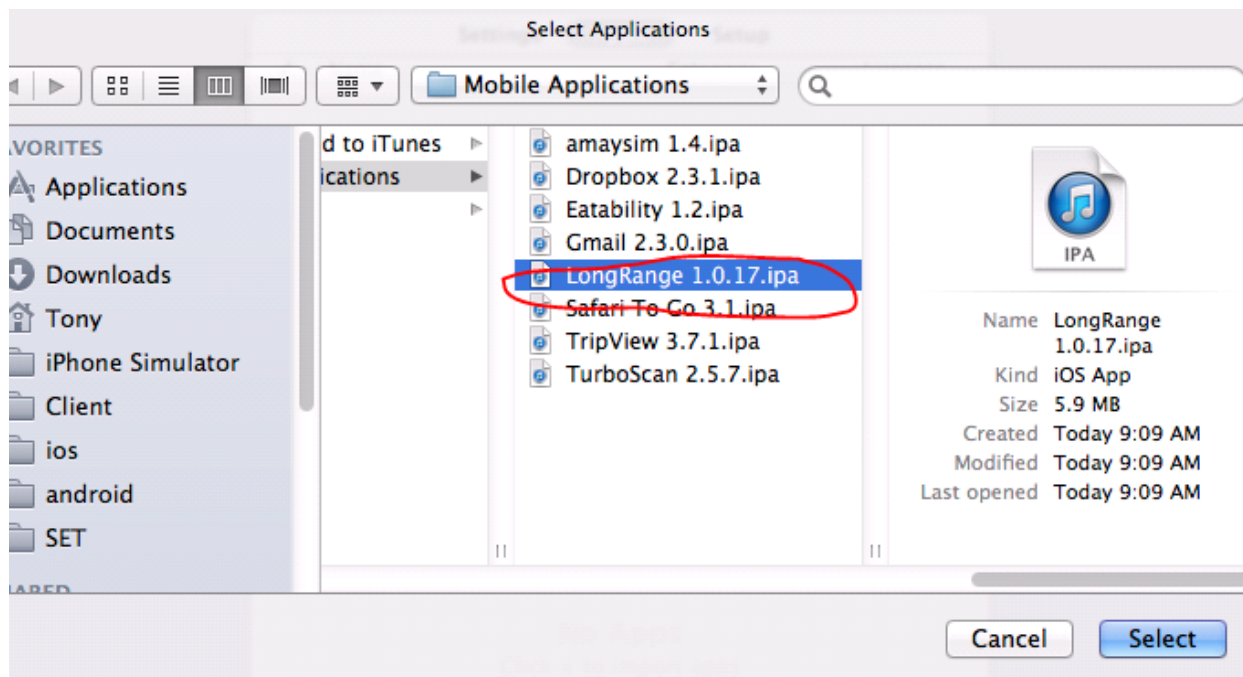
Launch Apple Configurator



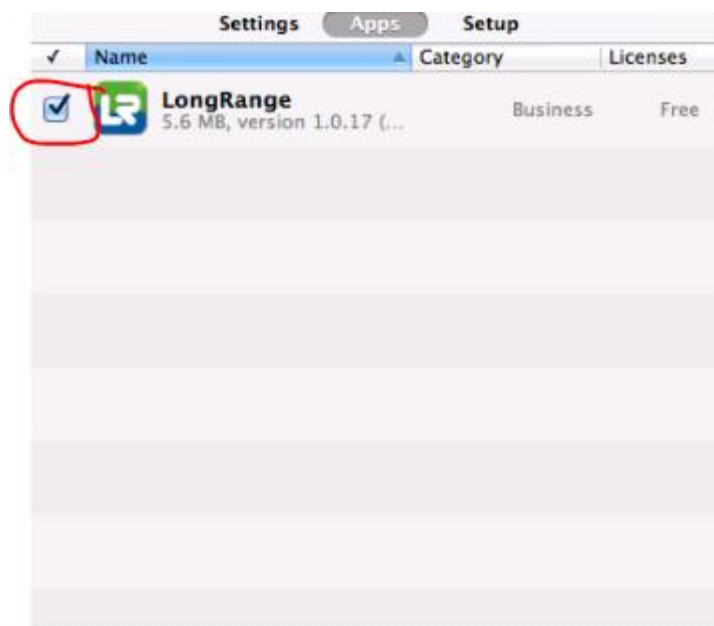
Change the 'Update iOS settings' to 'Never Update Device' (unless you'd like to update all your iOS devices to the latest iOS version).



Go to the "Apps" tab, and click on the "+" icon to add LongRange app:

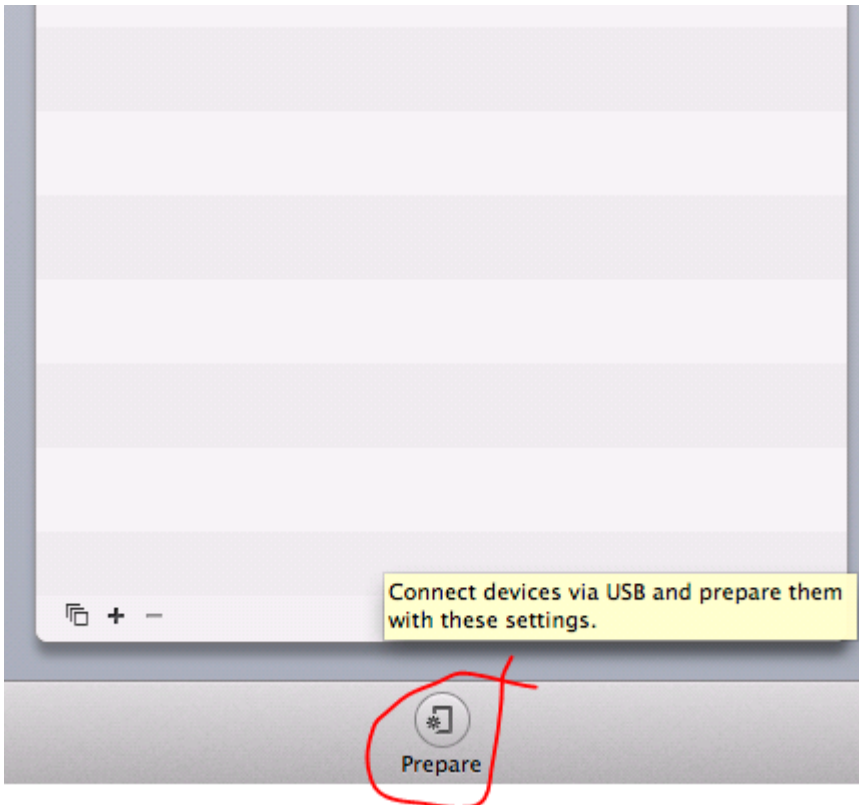


Tick the 'LongRange' app.

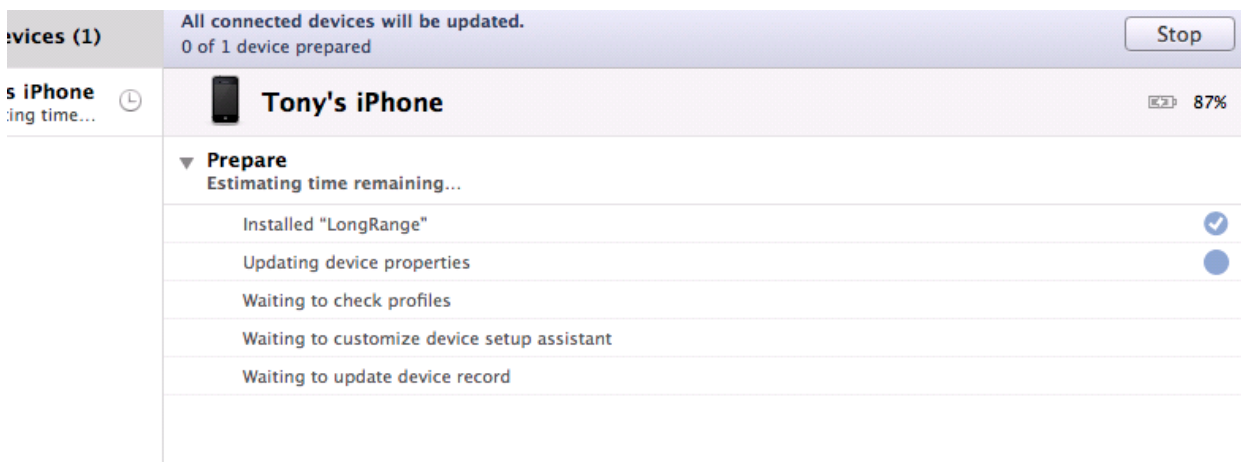


5. Install LongRange on iOS devices

Make sure your device is connected.



Click on the 'Prepare' button.



You should then see a progress details of the installation.

At the end of the process, LongRange would be installed on your device.

Repeat this step to install LongRange on other devices.
